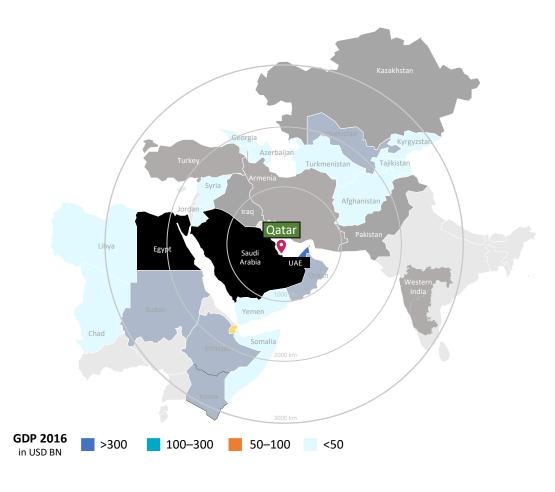






Qatar is positioned in the heart of the Gulf Region with 25 economies located within 3,000 km



- Tremendous markets and economic power within reach of <3,000 km
 - >2BN people
 - >6TN USD in combined GDP
- India and Pakistan offer large populations and domestic markets
- Qatar is well positioned to serve Iran and and help Iraq with rebuild activities
- Even markets like Turkey and CIS countries (Uzbekistan, Kazakhstan, etc.) are not beyond reach and offer industries with potential for logistics
- In the long-term, KSA is another potential market so serve

 currently it is not accessible
- Excellent access to the Eastern Africa market

FREIGHT FORWARDING FOR IMPORT/EXPORT

- Qatar imports machinery, electronic equipment, metal products etc. in large quantities to support its diversification strategy
- This, together with increasing importance of industrial exports, offers an opportunity to serve manufacturers in Mesaieed Industrial City and in Ras Laffan



COLD CHAIN CONTRACT LOGISTICS SERVICES

- Growing Qatar population fuels food imports; recend blocade by other GCC states re-imposed the importance of self-suffiency in food supply for Qatar
- Large-scale cold chain facilities and respective network to serve Doha food market is yet to be established



HIGH-PROTECTION STORAGE FOR VALUABLE GOODS

- Qatar imports of precious metals amounted to \$1.4 BN in 2016
- Provision of professional secure storage and handling



WORLD CUP FREIGHT FORWARDING AND PROJECT LOGISTICS

- Multi-billion investments in preparation for World Cup 2022
- Over 1.5 million tourists are expected to visit WC2022
- Significant demand for freight forwarding and logistics services both prior to and during WC construction



DISTRIBUTION NETWORK FOR E-COMMERCE

- Qatar's online B2C market is expected to grow at a compound annual rate of 17% over the next years
- It remains fairly fragmented, with mostly local players operating DCs and conducting pick-ups and deliveries
