Qatar is committed to clean energy, smart transportation and eco-friendly logistics with the electrification of the public transportation system under way and set to be fully e-powered by 2030.



1,100+

electric buses were used to ferry spectators during the FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™ and are now being used for public transportation in Qatar.

400+

electric charging stations are being built to support the development of electric and autonomous vehicles.



As a result of Qatar's sustainability initiatives, businesses can

benefit from sustainable opportunities in Qatar.

Qatar Energy updated its sustainability strategy in alignment with the goals of the Paris Agreement and set in motion a plan to reduce greenhouse gas emissions by 35% by 2030.



The strategy outlines some **key targets**:

- Two major projects to produce up to 1.6 GW of solar energy in 2024 and up to 5GW in 2035 Plan to expand the Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS) capacity over 11 MTPA from the current facilities of 2.2 MTPA in Ras Laffan (largest CO2 recovery and sequestration facility in the MENA region)
- Reduce CO2 emissions by improving operations efficiency (reduction of LNG emission intensity by 35% by 2030 and methane target of 0.2 wt.% by 2025)
- Continue efforts to eliminate routine flaring entirely by 2030

Backed by Qatar's National Climate Change Action Plan 2030, which aims to achieve:

5+ million

ton increase per annum in carbon capture and storage capacity by 2025 by expanding LNG production

26 million

ton CO₂ reduction by the Siraj-1 Solar Power Plant during its lifetime, the first large-scale power project in Qatar

These initiatives open a huge window of sustainable opportunities for foreign businesses, with further projects in blue and green hydrogen, CCS and biofuels to be expected.



A global hub for sports.

Qatar has hosted over 500 international sporting events in the last 15 years, fueled by supportive policies and investments as well as a leading medical ecosystem.

Qatar is actively investing to accelerate the sports industry by providing funding and access to expertise through projects such as the Sport Accelerator, the first sports economic hub of its kind in Qatar and the Middle East.

QFZ signed an MoU with the Sport Accelerator to facilitate new business opportunities across the sports value chain.



Home to the first specialized orthopedic and sports medicine hospital in the Gulf region.

Aspetar is one of few hospitals to have received both FIFA and IOC international recognition, as well as recognition as part of Asian Football Confederation's Medical Centre of Excellence.

FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™

Qatar hosted the first FIFA World Cup™ to ever be staged in the Middle East and welcomed over 1.4 million fans from across the globe.

2030 Asian Games

The 2030 Asian Games, officially known as the XXI Asiad and commonly known as Doha 2030, will be the twenty-first edition of the Asian Games, a pan-Asian multi-sport event that will be held in Doha, Qatar.

Esports

Qatar launched the Qatar Esports Wega Global Games in 2020, a three-year esports competition to develop the country's competitive environment, providing participants with greater opportunities to compete.

Formula 1

Qatar made its debut on the Formula 1 calendar in 2021 at the Lusail International Circuit and has signed a 10-year deal to host a Grand Prix from 2023.






